

Dictionary: Definitions in print, on a website, or on an online database.

Structure: Author Last, F. M. (Year, Month Date). Entry Name [Def. Number]. In F. M. Last (Ed.) & F. M. Last (Trans.), *Website Name*. Retrieved Month Date, Year, from URL

Note: Not all types of contributors will be relevant to each entry. The date of publication may not be available. If there is no date of publication, put (n.d.) in place of the date.
