



**Dictionary:** Definitions in print, on a website, or on an online database.



**Structure:** Author Last, F. M. (Year, Month Date). Entry Name [Def. Number]. In F. M. Last (Ed.) & F. M. Last (Trans.), *Website Name*. Retrieved Month Date, Year, from URL

**Note:** Not all types of contributors will be relevant to each entry. The date of publication may not be available. If there is no date of publication, put (n.d.) in place of the date.

## Definition on a Website



**ci·ta·tion**  *noun* \sī-'tā-shən\ ← **Entry Name**

**Definition of CITATION**  

**1** : an official summons to appear (as before a court)


**2 a** : an act of quoting; *especially* : the citing of a previously settled case at law ← **Definition Number of Choice: 2**


**b** : EXCERPT, QUOTATION

**3** : MENTION: as

**a** : a formal statement of the achievements of a person receiving an academic honor

**b** : specific reference in a military dispatch to meritorious performance of duty
